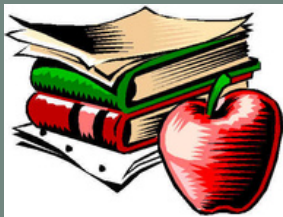
## Affton Community Volunteers Organization

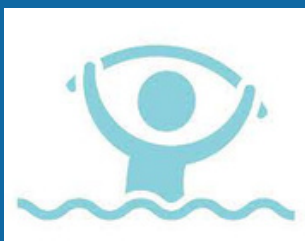

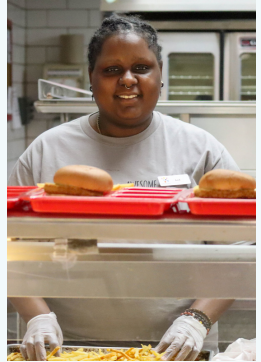

## Students learn about core values

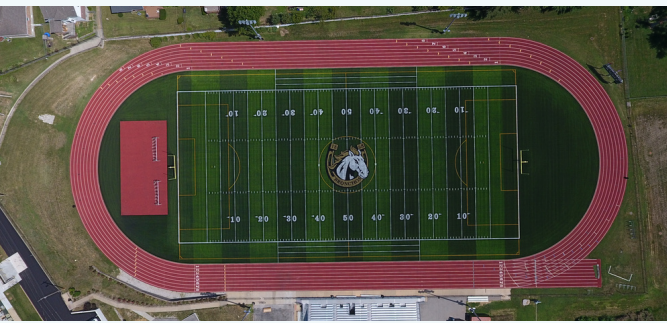
